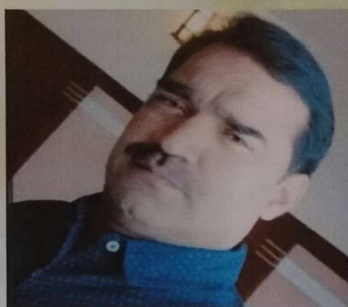

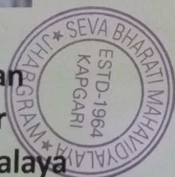

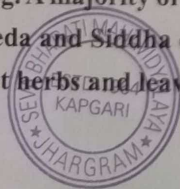

About the theme:

India is a developing nation. The majority of its population lives in rural areas. The history of man and human society can be vividly described as been characterized by continuous interactions between man and his environment. The relationship between the man and the environment has been established in the early periods itself. Human beings live in the kingdom of nature and interact with it constantly. The influence of nature in the form of the air he breathes, the water he drinks, the food he eats, and the flow of energy and information. Any change in the environment can not only result in devastating effects, but can also pose a threat to the human race. The social environment consists of three kinds of environment, Economic, cultural and psycho-social environments. The economic environment consists of all the economic goods, houses and roads, lands and gardens, domestic animals, machines, stores of manufactured articles; in short, all the comforts and conveniences which man has made to deliver him out of the 'state of nature.' Economic order is, in other words, an order of everyday life which man has built up for the satisfying of his needs through production, exchange, distribution and consumption of wealth. That relationship between human society and the natural environment is the core concern to enrich the society. Environmental stability is itself one of the Millennium Development Goals, and there is a close and symbiotic relationship between it and all the others. German Sociologist, Ulrich Beck's risk society theory suggests there is a movement away from traditional social institutions and industrial society, and towards a new society which is individual, global and self-confrontational (reflexive). Environmental or Critical realism developed as an alternative approach which attempts to approach environmental issues in a scientific way (Giddens 2009). The hunter gathering tribes and the settled agriculture tribes totally depend on the forest for their livelihood and their way of life is no way harm the sustainability of the forest. If people's life is to be improved in an environment friendly way, it should be without being subject to the destructive way of harvesting. A majority of Non-Timber-Forest Products in forest is for medicinal uses. The genesis of Indian native medicines of Ayurveda and Siddha can be traced to what called ethno medicines is practiced by the tribal communities. It is reported that forest herbs and leaves are the best medicines for immunity, fertility, abortion, asthma, jaundice, itching, etc.



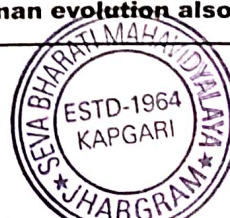
