The college is affiliated to Vidyasagar University. Presently, the college offers B.A., B.Sc., B.Com. (Honours & General) and B.P.Ed. courses. The establishment of Seva Bharati Mahavidyalaya on 17* of July, 1964 marked the fruition of the dream of Dr. Pabitra Kumar Sen, an eminent educationist, who was prompted by the urgent necessity of providing the young minds of the remote poor village and its adjacent areas with quality higher education. From the very inception in 1964, the avowed purpose of the college had been to cater to the need of higher education of the students of SC, ST-dominated, underdeveloped and socially underprivileged backward rural area of Jhargram Sub-Division of erstwhile Midnapore district. The students of this college are mostly the first-generation learners. Empowering the poor and academically backward people of Kapgari and its adjoining areas was the sole aim and objective of founding the Mahavidyalaya.



About Gourav Guin Memorial College

Gourav Guin Memorial College, a co-educational General degree college situated in Chandrakona Road, Paschim Medinipore, was established on 28th August 2008. The District of Paschim Medinipur in West Bengal is well-known as the birth-place of Pandit Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar who became a pioneer in the field of Education in India in an age of ignorance and illiteracy, always being an inspiration and ideal for all for his reformation in the area of Child Education, Women's Education as well as Adult Education. But a good part of Paschim Medinipur, especially its Jangal Mahal, has always remained an educationally backward area because of its geographical location.
